Journey Duration : Scenic Day Trips

Day to Day Itinerary

Your journey begins at Bergen Central Station. Through the Lowlands, the train departs Bergen and travels towards Oslo, passing charming villages and scenic countryside. Drammen is the first major stop, where the landscape starts to change as the train enters wilder terrain. The Bergen Railway follows the course of beautiful valleys and rivers, offering stunning mountain views. Vikenersund and Hønefoss are interesting stops along the route, offering glimpses into local life.

As you continue, you'll pass Nesbyen, Gol, and Geilo, all popular winter sports destinations. The train ascends through Hallingdalen valley, with steeper inclines, reaching one of Europe's highest mountain plateaus. Finse is the highest station on the line (1222 meters) and offers dramatic views of the Hardangerjøkulen glacier nearby. You might also see the Rallar Road, an old service road for construction workers.

Located on the maritime coast of Norway, Myrdal is a station without road access for cars. This is where the famous Flåm Railway branches off, a popular detour for some travelers. The journey continues through a breathtaking landscape of cascading waterfalls, lush forests, and majestic fjords. Lastly, your train trip concludes at Oslo Sentralstasjon (Oslo Central Station).
